2021 ENTRIES ARE NOW OPEN - EVERY SECONDARY SCHOOL ACROSS AUSTRALIA IS INVITED TO NOMINATE UP TO TWO YOUNG LEADERS WHO ARE DRIVING CHANGE.

Each Award recipient will receive;

- Invitation to attend a national-wide virtual Olympic Forum
- Certificate of recognition
- Consideration to attend the National Olympic Change-Maker Summit where they will collaborate with other young leaders and Olympians, with attendees selected by a panel of Olympians and;
- Invitation into the Australian Olympic Change-Maker Alumni

The Virtual Olympic Forum will be held to provide students the opportunity to share ideas and be immersed in a unique Olympic experience as well as learning firrsthand from Olympians.

Additionally, up to 25 students from all States and Territories will participate in a National Olympic Change-Maker Summit in December 2021.

A PANEL OF OLYMPIANS **REVIEWED MORE THAN 400 VIDEO SUBMISSIONS, FROM WHICH 21 STUDENTS FROM AROUND AUSTRALIA WERE SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE** IN THE SUMMIT.
