Multiple Choice

The Assessor is an educator with expertise in the HSC examination and the development and styling requirements of multiple-choice and options. The Assessor must be either a practising teacher, university lecturer in secondary education or educational consultant. A minimum of five years HSC teaching experience is required. They are appointed by the CSSA to independently review multiple choice and options and provide comment on both the examination and marking guidelines.

Applicants from all three school sectors are encouraged to apply.

- Inclusion of three professional referees including current Principal

Some of the above information in current Curriculum Vitae may not be relevant to include if a university lecturer or educational consultant.
