

## New free resources developed by teachers for teachers, from Ochre Education and AERO

New Australian not for profit Ochre Education and The Australian Education Research Organisation (AERO) have launched a series of sequenced, free video lessons and curriculum resources developed by teachers, beginning with materials in primary English and maths to support schools in Term 1.

These resources can save teachers time and ease the pressure in finding and creating teaching and learning resources that embed evidence-based practices. They are also an instant back-up to support teachers with remote learning and lesson cover. The resource include a Schedule, with a recommended student timetable for daily and weekly lessons.

The resources are available for teachers to use as they wish, to complement their existing teaching and planning. Teachers can now access:

- nearly 100 high-quality video lessons in primary maths and English
- about 400 resources such as lesson slides, worksheets and quizzes
- fully sequenced curriculum maps, detailing overviews of the content, units and principles for each subject.

An additional 200 Ochre video lessons and accompanying resources will be progressively released in Term 1 2022, including further primary maths and English lessons, and materials in secondary science.
