ICUP is a national initiative created by **Together For Humanity (TFH)** and funded by the Australian Government.

ICUP provides opportunities for you to work closely with TFH and its partners, the **Jewish Christian Muslim Association (JCMA)** in Victoria and **The Abraham Institute** in South Australia, to address a cross-cultural challenge in your school community.

If your ICUP application is successful, you will receive **up to \$10,000** to address your challenge and improve the learning and wellbeing of your students. You will also have the **opportunity to work collaboratively with an experienced ICUP facilitator**, located in your state or territory, throughout your project.

We believe that working together is more effective than working in isolation – good partnerships create benefits for all partners. We value partnerships where we work collaboratively towards a common goal.

- 71 schools
- 5 states
- 63 projects
- Participating schools included small and large, public and private, primary and secondary schools in metropolitan and regional areas.

- providing regional students with an understanding of, and connection to, people from different cultures
