Shelley (@fivemooreminutes) is a highly sought-after teacher, researcher, speaker and storyteller and has worked with school districts and community organisations around the world, in supporting and promoting equity for all learners.

Thanks to the internet, Australian educators have been learning from Shelley for a number of years. It all started with a bowling video about changing our aim (click here if you haven't yet seen it!) and has been followed by her Five Moore Minutes video series, a TEDx talk, and her book *One Without the Other*.

In these workshops, Shelley will look at how the goals of inclusion have shifted and evolved as we learn more about diversity, identity, and equity. *Rather than trying to include a few students who are different, we are striving to teach TO the difference.*

Shelley will share examples of how multiple inclusive frameworks can be integrated in ways that can guide collaborative planning teams to design for diversity rather than retrofitting for deficits.

Participants will reflect on their own contexts and consider next steps for advocacy and action.

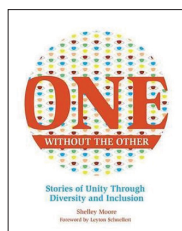
